## **ABSTRACT**

Pancasila, as the foundation of Indonesia, has an important role in building the nation's character. This article discusses the Pancasila values socialization activity conducted on 1 November 2022 at SMK Negeri 8 Medan, to improve students' understanding of the importance of Pancasila in the school environment. The activity involved lectures and discussions designed to increase interaction between resource persons and students so that Pancasila values can be more easily internalized and applied in daily life. The lecture method was used to provide basic information about Pancasila, while the group discussion allowed students to discuss the application of the values in a real context. The results of the activity showed that the 11th-grade students majoring in Fashion had a better understanding of the importance of Pancasila and were enthusiastic about applying its values. The active participation of students during the activity also showed that the method used was effective in delivering the material. The success of this activity shows the importance of Pancasila education in shaping student character and facing the challenges of globalization. It is hoped that similar activities can be carried out regularly to strengthen students' understanding and awareness of Pancasila so that these values can continue to be the moral and ethical foundation for Indonesia's young generation.

## **INTRODUCTION**

In addition, Pancasila also serves as a filter for outside cultures that enter the nation's culture, preventing the misuse of Pancasila values, especially in the educational environment. This is very important to maintain the integrity and cultural identity of the nation in the midst of globalization (Eka et al., 2021).

The socialization activities carried out at SMK Negeri 8 Medan aim to instil an understanding of the importance of Pancasila in the school environment. This activity involves lectures and discussions to increase interaction between speakers and participants so that students can better understand and apply the values of Pancasila in everyday life. The lecture method is used to raise students' awareness of the importance of Pancasila in the school environment, while the discussion method is applied so that students can understand the material that has been delivered through a question-and-answer process. ## **METHODOLOGY**

- 2. The discussion method is applied so that vocational students can understand the material that has been delivered and the question and answer process to increase understanding of Pancasila.

## **RESULTS & DISCUSSION**

The socialization activity on the importance of Pancasila in the school environment held on November 1, 2022, at SMK Negeri 8 Medan was successfully implemented and received a positive response from students of class XI majoring in Fashion Management. The activity involved lectures and discussions designed to enhance students' understanding of the values of Pancasila and its application in daily life.

In the lecture session, the resource person explained the meaning and history of Pancasila, as well as the values contained in each of its principles. The results of this socialization activity showed that the 11th-grade students majoring in Fashion Management at SMK Negeri 8 Medan had a better understanding of the importance of Pancasila and how to apply it in the school and community environment. The enthusiasm of the students in participating in each session of the activity showed that the methods used, namely lectures and discussions, were effective in delivering the material and improving students' understanding.
